



Afternoon care (NAB) at DSK Tygerberg 2024

The afternoon programme begins immediately after the last lesson, usually at 12.15 p.m. (see class schedule). Those who stay after class either go to an extra mural or to the study / homework lesson. Those who still attend school at 1 p.m. sit down at a long table with their lunch. Food can be heated in the microwave oven. After lunch, there is supervised play time or participation in an extra mural.

Ms. Anka Schröder is the responsible supervisor from 2.30 p.m. to 5 p.m. (Fridays from 12.15 p.m.).

Please explain the following rules to your child:

1. All children stay/play where they can always see the supervisor.
2. Silence in and around the classrooms (12:15-13:00) is to be respected by all learners as well as adults.
3. No eating during study / homework lesson or near the computers.
4. All learners are quietly occupied in the classroom and stay inside until the lesson is over.
5. Children respect the property of the class they are in. Everyone tidies up before they leave.
6. Lunch: when eating, we sit quietly at one place.
7. **All school rules also apply during afternoon care.**
8. Before leaving, children say goodbye to the supervisor. **The person picking up the child must sign out the child / children on the class list in front of the respective class.** Please print your name clearly.
9. If your child is picked up by someone other than usual, the supervisor must be **notified in advance**.
10. Please collect your child on time. (Pick-up times, depending on the schedule: **at 12:15 / at 13:00 / until 14:15 / until 16:00 / until 17:00**)
11. If this is not possible in exceptional cases, please notify the supervisor in good time. In case of late pick-up, the daily rate will be billed additionally.

Gate Tag - Safety Rules:

1. Whoever opens the gate, is responsible for those who go in or out.
2. No unfamiliar people are allowed to walk through the open gate. Please address them and accompany them to a teacher or to the caretaker.
3. No child may leave the school premises without the person responsible for collection.
4. The person picking up, must sign out ALL the children he/she collects on the list in front of their respective classrooms. Please say goodbye to the responsible supervisor.
5. If a gate tag is lost, it must be reported immediately.
6. Under no circumstances are children allowed to climb onto the gate! Only adults are allowed to operate the tags.
7. A deposit of R100 is paid for each gate tag.
