To be eligible for admission you must have obtained the National Senior Certificate with 7 examination courses and an overall average result of 70% (the courses Life Orientation and Mathematical Literacy are not included in the calculation of average result) + 1 Independent Examinations Board (IEB) Advanced Programme Certificate (Mathematics or English) with a result of at least 55%.

Thank you for sending these through – you'll be pleased to hear that we were able to make an unconditional offer to the South African student who had applied for BA English Literature with us. The feedback received from the course director on reviewing the syllabus was this:

“It looks to me as if about half the credits on the syllabus are for some kind of literary study, and quite a few of the others are in respect of reading and interpreting skills that would be relevant too. So it's a bit like the Language and Literature A level here. ...”

Our School of Literature, Drama and Creative Writing has a long established international reputation in literary studies and is considered **a UK Top 10 English department**. So I hope that the comments from our course director are well received by you and your colleagues. **This information will now make it easier for us to accept and process applications from students who apply for a course where an English A-Level or equivalent is required.**

Our MB ChB programme will be a four and a half year course. Fees will be **£36,500** per annum which is comparable to international fees at a number of UK medical schools.

Because of our independent status, there will be **no cap on international student places**.

We recognise the South African **IEB** qualifications and academic entry requirements are 4 NSC/IEB subjects at grade 7 (or A) including chemistry (or physical sciences) and life sciences and at least a grade 6 (or B) in English and Maths.

The second phase of selection is an 8 station task designed to evaluate attributes that make a good doctor (as defined in the GMC's Good Medical Practice document). This assessment takes place at the University of Buckingham.
